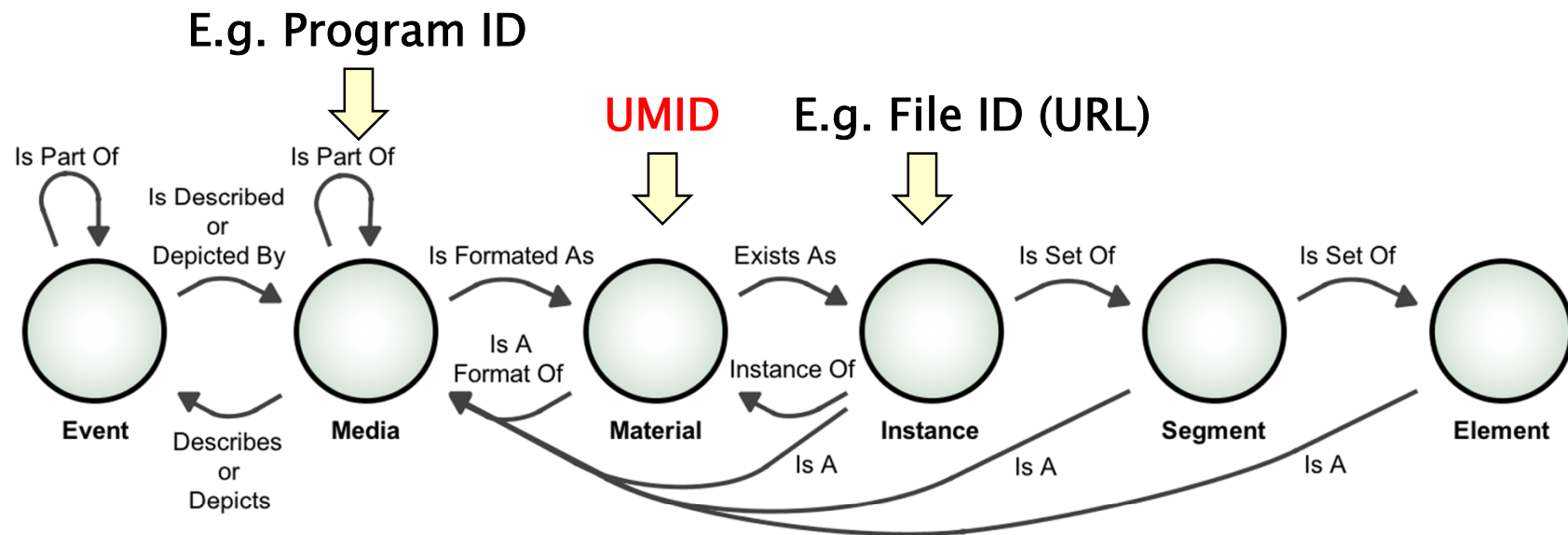

## ▶ Activities since the Burbank


- “Study Report Part 2–2” still under development
