SG: UMID Applications

- Activities since the Ottawa meeting
 - Started to explore how UMID can contribute to the “material” identity and integrity (inspired by a new project of “C2PA over MXF” occurring in 31FS)

DG: UMID Related Standards

- Activities since the Ottawa meeting
 - RP 205 1-Year Review
 - Conducted careful text review by HQ before publication and identified serious problems
 - Found to require revisions in the normative parts and substantive revisions in the informative parts,
 - Ms. Ellen Ryan's dedicated effort on the careful text review from not only the editorial but also the technical viewpoints is very much appreciated!!
 - Agreed to conduct another FCD ballot so that an engineering document of the highest quality to be delivered to the industry
 - The FCD package to be prepared for another FCD ballot contains:
 - Starting text after the previous FCD ballot (before the ST audit),
 - Full redlines text resulted from the careful text review,
 - Becomes awfully messy due to the document template change and compliance with ISO Directives,
 - Another "simplified" redlines text for reviewers' convenience,
 - Only the parts that require their intensive reviews are redlined
 - Clean text

Next Step

 - To identify the UMID roles in a context of the “material” identity and integrity (especially in MXF)
 - To assist the DG and other relevant activities as appropriate
 - To explore new work items
